

Safety improvement work on the Old Northern Road, between Dural and Wisemans Ferry, from Monday 15 May

The NSW Government is funding this \$432,000 project to improve safety for road users.

Roads and Maritime Services will be replacing missing or damaged signs, replacing road marking and installing rails on existing safety barriers at various locations on Old Northern Road between Dural and Wisemans Ferry.

An analysis of five year crash data, between July 2009 and June 2014, for this area shows 30 crashes involving motorcycles.

This work aims to provide better advanced warning and greater guidance for motorists driving around bends and to reduce the occurrence and severity of crashes.

Our work schedule

We will be on site for **five shifts** a week for **six weeks** between **Monday 15 May** and **Friday 14 July**, excluding public holidays, weather permitting. Our work hours will be between **7am** and **5pm** from **Monday to Friday**.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact.

Traffic changes

Temporary traffic changes will continue to be in place to make sure the work zone is safe.
